## Our impressive list of speakers

Prof Michael Nicholas is a clinical psychologist and Professor in the Faculty of Medicine, University of Sydney at Royal North Shore Hospital. He has been working in the pain area since 1980, with stints at multidisciplinary pain clinics in Sydney and London.



Prof Nicholas directs the multidisciplinary ADAPT pain management program at the RNSH Pain management & Research Centre and is actively involved in research and teaching on psychological aspects of pain. His current research includes: understanding persistent low back pain where it resides in the brain; and new approaches to prevent chronic low back pain.

Prof. Nicholas will very clearly lead us through the complexities of chronic pain, the traps that patients fall into and how to prevent such adverse outcomes. A roadmap of management will be presented using Prof. Nicholas' clinical experience showing indicators for variations in presentations and behaviours.

Dr Carlo Rinaudo is Macquarie graduate from the class of 2000 and since undertaken extensive studies in Chiropractic Neuro-rehabilitation. Carlo recognised as a Diplomate of the American Chiropractic Neurology Board and is a Fellow of the Australasian Academy of functional Neurology, and is very highly regarded by his teachers and peers in neuroscience.



Dr Rinaudo has taught neurology to students at Macquarie University and practitioners across the profession. His areas of clinical interest include patients with balance disorders, dizziness, concussions, whiplash, headaches, and movement disorders.

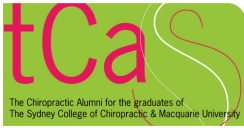
Dr Rinaudo's studies in clinical neuroscience and its application have led him to train with Prof Ted Carrick at the Carrick Brain Centres in the USA and participating in further training in concussion and vestibular rehabilitation.

Dr. Rinaudo will explain how different the chronic pain patient is neurologically and some aspects of assessing the patient; how to assess progress and when to co-manage or when to refer.

Dr Ian Thong has a PhD in neuroscience and works as a rural GP. His areas of interest include: pain medicine – acute and chronic, paediatric to elderly; musculoskeletal medicine; drug and alcohol dependency; palliative care; pain management in primary care.



Dr. Thong will cover the role of GP in managing chronic pain. The role of manual therapies in managing pain - when it is helpful and unhelpful; establishing an effective partnership between health professionals managing the same patient with chronic pain.
